- c) How did Captain Anuj Nayyar prove himself worthy of a "Maha Vir Chakra"?

 Ans: The task of recapturing the Point 4875 was given to Captain Anuj Nayyar, of the 17 Jat Regiment, and his team. With the orders of Nayyar, the soldiers fought with the enemies valiantly turning the peak into the dust of battle. f) Was Rehman a good son? Give examples from the story.
