6. Answer the following question (all)

- a. The old gardener was making the offering to the previous generation. He had eaten fruits from the vines planted by his previous generation and so he planted for those who were yet to come when he would be no more. He was grateful to his previous generation and due to that gratitude he wanted to leave behind fruits for his next generation.
- b. Yes, Lawrence Lemieux deserved the medal he was awarded. He was awarded Pierre de Coubertin Medal for Sportsmanship for displaying tremendous sportsmanship, self-sacrifice and courage. Later he was also

included into the Alberta Sports Hall of Fame. Lawrence Lemieux proved to be an embodiment of Olympic spirit. At the crucial juncture where character was tested, he took the gold. According to him, "The first rule of sailing is, you see someone in trouble, you help him." He struggled for 15 years while preparing for that race. But he sacrificed his medal for saving the lives of other sailors. And, in that weather he went to save the sailors, battling with the waves and wind.

- c. Old age is very often like a second childhood and old Kaki was like a very young child. She had no interest in life except food and no means of drawing attention to herself except by weeping. Almost blind and crippled, she lay on the floor in her room all day, howling as if she were left hungry for long or denied any tasty tidbits that others might be eating. Even after Roopa's rude behaviour towards Kaki, when Roopa asked for forgiveness from Kaki while offering her food to eat, like a child who can be happy in an instant forgetting all the wrongs done to her, Kaki forgot all that had happened and joyfully began to eat.
- d. When Roopa saw desperate Kaki in her hunger picking up and devouring whatever little bits of food were left on the dirty leaf plates, she was filled with shame and remorse. She felt that with Kaki's money she led a comfortable life but couldn't treat Kaki with respect and give any attention to her. She also felt that she fed hundreds of people and spent hundreds of rupees that day, but her very own Kaki did not even get a meal and all because Kaki was old, helpless and dependent on them.

When Roopa offered the tray with generous helpings of all that had been cooked that day to Kaki, like a child who can be happy in an instant, forgetting all the wrongs done to it, Kaki forgot all that had happened and joyfully began to eat. This showed Kaki did not keep any kind of ill feelings towards Roopa.

- e. Deepika had a friend Rohan who was a boy and whom she felt was intelligent, a good talker, a good listener and decent. Rohan was not Deepika's rakhi brother and her parents had no restrictions about it. They were liberal and allowed Deepika to have her own choice of friends.
