(a) Why did Rehman sell his cow to Lala Daudayal? What does this show about him?

Ans: Rehman needed money desperately so he went out to sell his cow. He was surrounded by many customers offering higher than expected, but he sold his cow to Lala Daudayal for the loss of five valuable rupees, just to ensure that his cow did not fall into the hands of butcher.

This shows Rehman's compassion for his cow that even after selling to Lala Daudayal, he requested him not to beat her.

(b) "From now on, I am your slave," Why did Rehman call himself a slave?

Ans: Rehman could not repay the amount he borrowed from Lala and thus he was called in his home. Instead of punishing or extorting money from him, he was given two calves and all his dues were spared. Observing all these, Rehman could not control his tears and called himself a slave of that person.

- (c) Give an account of bravery displayed by Captain Vikram Batra during recapture of the two peaks.
