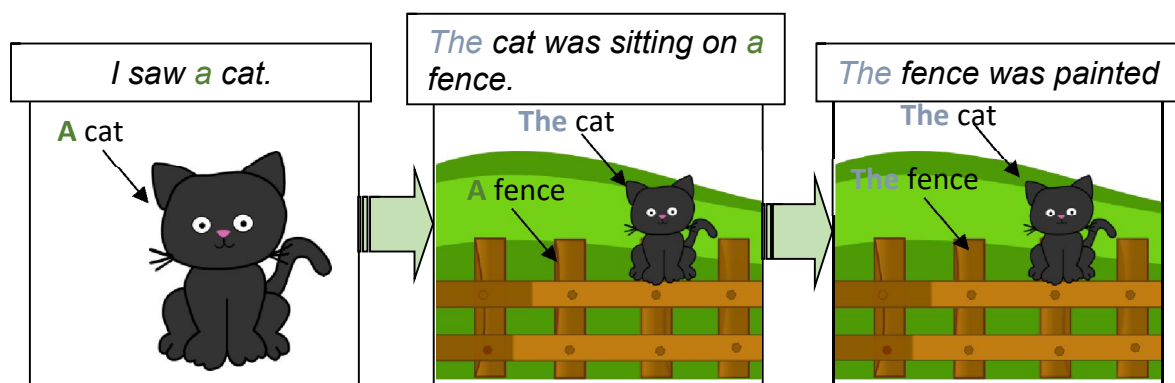

One, Any Singular	One, Any Singular	Specific thing, Singular, Plural
Before consonant sound 'A' is used the first time you say a person, place or thing.	Before vowel sound	Before something specific. . 'THE' is used the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and etc.. times that you say a person, place or thing

Example: I saw *a* cat. *The* cat was sitting on *a* fence. *The* fence was painted brown.

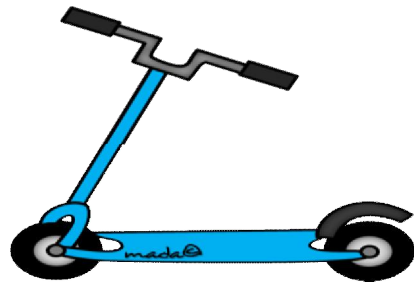
