Solve the following:

1. There were 444 puppies in a pet shop. If 279 puppies were sold. How many puppies are left in the shop?

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Number of puppies in a pet shop} & 444 \\ \text{Number of puppies sold} & - 279 \\ \hline \text{Number of puppies left in the shop} & 165 \end{array}$$

Answer : 165 puppies are left in the shop.

2. Manoj ordered 565 books for himself and 478 for his sister. Find out the total number of books he ordered ?

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Number of books Manoj ordered for himself} & 565 \\ \text{Number of books ordered for his sister} & + 478 \\ \hline \text{Total number of books ordered by Manoj} & 1043 \end{array}$$

Answer : Manoj ordered 1043 number of books in all.

3. A bank has 49 employees in each branch. If it has 7 such branches. Find the total number of employees the bank has in all ?

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{Number of employees a branch has} & 49 \\ \text{Number of branches} & \times 7 \\ \hline \text{Number of employees in all} & 343 \end{array}$$

Answer : There are 343 employees in all .

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
