'<u>Has</u>' or '<u>have</u>' are verbs that tell us what people own. They are called <u>having verbs</u>.

Use of 'Has'

Word 'Has' shows possession of something.

'<u>Has</u>' is used in a <u>singular noun</u> or <u>singular</u> <u>pronoun</u>.

We use 'has' with 'he', 'she' and 'it'.

Example:



It has a pillow.



He **has** a guitar.

Use of 'Have'


Word 'Have' is used to show possession of something.

'<u>Have</u>' is used with <u>some pronouns</u> and <u>plural</u> nouns.

We use 'Have' with 'I', 'you', 'we' and 'they'.

Example:







l <u>have</u> a present for you.
