(Consonants: b, c, d ,f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, y, z.)


Example: a man, a dog, a tiny ant

We use '<u>An</u>' before words that begin with a <u>vowel</u>.


(Vowels: a, e, i, o, u)
