

### PERSONAL PRONOUN

#### Persons

First person (the speaker) (I, me, we, us)

**Second person** (the person spoken to) (you)

**Third person** (the ones spoken about) (he, him, she, her, it, they, them)

### Genders

Feminine - she, her

Masculine - he, him

**Neuter** – it, they, them

## Example:

- 1. She is a nice girl.
- 2. He likes ice-cream.
- 3. It doesn't work

# **Numbers**

Singular – I, you, he, she, it, me, him, her

**Plural** – we, you, they, us, them

### Example:

- 1. I like to play cricket.
- 2. You may get good marks in this exam.
