Steps to be followed while writing a paragraph.

- A paragraph writing should start with an <u>"Indent Format"</u>, that is, <u>you should leave</u> <u>"Two-finger gap"</u> and start writing the paragraph.
- Paragraph writing consists of a <u>Single Paragraph</u>. We should start the paragraph with the Indent Format and continue <u>till you finish it with the concluding line.</u>
- **Heading** of the Paragraph should be **given and underlined**.
- We begin the paragraph with the **Introduction Line** which is called a **Topic Sentence**.
- A Topic Sentence is the **first sentence** of the paragraph that introduces the topic.
- Rest of the sentences should agree and support the topic sentence. This is called the 'Body of the Paragraph''.
- Lastly, a line should be written which acts as a **conclusion of the paragraph**.

Picture format of the process of writing a Paragraph :-

	Introduction Line
	Body of the Paragraph
