- 1. Money Bill is only introduced in Lok Sabha.
- 2. No bill is passed unless passed by both houses.
- 3. Incase of dispute a majority vote in a **Joint Sitting** is taken into consideration.
- 4. A bill after receiving the **<u>President's assent</u>** becomes an Act.
- 5. A **permission** is obtained one month before a bill is introduced.
- 6. A **minister** doesnot have to seek permission to introduce a bill.
- 7. <u>Select Committee</u> will send back a bill with recommendation to Lok Sabha.
- 8. If Rajya Sabha amends a bill it is send back to Lok Sabha.
- 9. Article **<u>110</u>** gives a definition to Money Bill.
- 10. Custody of <u>consolidated fund</u> falls under Money Bill.
- 11. Ordinary Bills cannot propose the *imposition of taxes.*
- 12. Rajya Sabha has to send back a bill within 14 days.
- 13. Rajya Sabha believes in no taxation without representation.
- 14. Article **<u>250</u>** gives parliament the power to legislate subjects in State List.
- 15. Article **<u>312</u>** empowers Parliament to make laws regarding all India Services.
