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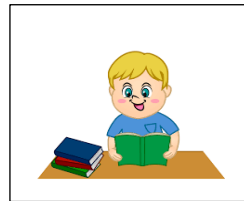
VERBS

The main verb shows action. The **helping verb** tells more about the action. **Helping verbs** usually **comes before the main verb** in a sentence.

For example: a. I **am** studying for my test.

b. She **is** buying vegetables.

c. They **are** dancing on the stage.



In the above sentences these are the helping verbs **is, am, are**.

Linking verbs links a noun or pronoun with a word that describes it.

For example: a. She **is** a naughty girl.

Here '**is**' = **linking verb**.

'**is**' links the pronoun **she** with the word that describes it (naughty girl).



Some **Was, were, had, has have, be, being, been, can, could, will, would, shall, should, may, might, do, does, did, must**

We use **am** with **I = I am**

Example: I **am** reading a book.

We use **is** with **he, she, It** and **singular nouns**.

Example: He **is** playing the guitar.

We use **are** with **you, we, they** and **plural nouns**

Example: You **are** singing well.

I am sad



I am happy

You are scared



You are sick



She is mad

She is bad



He is calm



He is angry

It is sleepy



It is surprised

We are thirsty



We are bored

They are hungry



They are tired
