1. The number of casualties in 2015 earthquake in Nepal was reported to be around (8000/ 8800/ 9000).
2. In the same earthquake more than (12,000/ 16,000/ 20,000) people suffered serious injuries.
3. During 2015 Nepal Earthquake, most number of injuries of most number of people were reported from (Pokhara/ Dharan/ Sindhupalchowok) district.
4. During this earthquake (Gorkha/ Dolakha/ Dharahara) Tower collapsed completely.
5. Bhaktapur is a town located near (Kathmandu/ Bharatpur/ Birganj).
6. The entire village of (Taleju/ Dolakha/ Ghodatabela) was wiped out by an avalanch in the 2015 Nepal Earthquake.
