SIMPLE PRESENT AND PAST TENSE


SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE talks about actions which a person does every day and it also tells us about permanent truths. Example: I eat an apple every day. The sun sets in the west. Birds fly in the sky. With 'I', 'we', 'you', 'they' and 'all other plural subjects' We use, subject +original form of the verb. Birds <u>fly</u> in the sky. Original form of the verb subject With 'he', 'she', 'it' and 'all other singular subjects in the third person'. We use, subject + original form of the verb+ s/es/ies The sun sets in the west Original form of the verb + s subject

SIMPLE PAST TENSE tells us about an action that already happened in the past or it talks about some past habits.

Example: I ate the apple.

I went to the fair yesterday.

The birds <u>flew</u> over the tree.
