Read and observe the sentences given below:

1. <u>Rohan</u> is a **strong boy**.

Here, the word strong tells us what kind of boy Rohan is. It describes Rohan.

2. The man has a heavy box on his lap.

Here, the word **heavy** tells us what kind of box is on the man's lap. It **describes** the <u>box</u>.

3. <u>He</u> has a **black** car.

Here, the word **black** tells us what colour car he has. It describes the car.

4. A square has four sides.

Here, the word **four** tells us how many sides a square has. It **describes** a <u>square</u>.

5. <u>He</u> lives in a **huge** house.

Here, the word huge tells us of what size the house is. It describes the house.

The word strong, heavy, black, four and huge describe the boy, box, car, square and house which are all Nouns.

They are, therefore, called **Describing words**.

Words which describe Nouns are called **Adjectives**.

All Describing words are Adjectives.
