2. My voice startled her. (change the voice)      Ans: She was startled by my voice.

3. "Are you going all the way to Dehra?" I asked. (change the narration)

Ans: I asked whether she was going all the way to Dehra.

4. "You are a very gallant young man", she said, "but why are you so serious?" (change the narration)

Ans: She said that I was a very gallant young man but expressed her astonishment as to why I was so serious.

5. I was unable to tell what the girl looked like. (change to a simple sentence)

Ans: I was unable to tell anything about the girl's appearance.

6. I must have been sitting in a dark corner, because my voice startled her. (change to a compound sentence)

Ans: My voice startled her, so I must have been sitting in a dark corner.

7. She was silent. (change to a negative sentence)      Ans: She was not speaking.

8. It shouldn't be too difficult. (change to an affirmative sentence)

Ans: It should be quite easy.

9. I can't bear to sit in a train for more than two or three hours. (change to a complex sentence)

Ans: I can't bear to sit in a train if it is for more than two or three hours.

10. Where are you going? (change to an assertive sentence)

Ans: I wonder where you are going.

11. October is the best time. (change to an interrogative sentence)

Ans: Isn't October the best time?

12. Her voice had the sparkle of a mountain stream. (use 'sparkle' as a verb)

Ans: Her voice sparkled like a mountain stream.

13. This is the best time. (use the positive degree)

Ans: No other time is as good as this.

14. I liked the sound of her voice, and even the sound of her slippers. (rewrite using 'not only'... 'but also')

Ans: I not only liked the sound of her voice, but also the sound of her slippers.

15 a. It is an interesting face. It can also be pretty. (join to form a simple sentence)

Ans: An interesting face can also be pretty.

b. The man who had entered the compartment broke into my reverie. (split into short simple sentences)
