### PRESENT AND PAST TENSE

**PRESENT TENSE** of a verb tells that something is happening now or in the present.

- Present (today, now, currently)

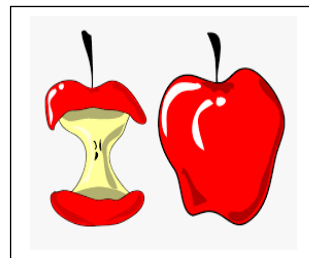
Example: I am eating the apple.



**PAST TENSE** of a verb tells that something already happened.

- Past (yesterday, earlier, long ago)

Example: I ate the apple.
