Topic : Division & Mental Maths

Division means equal sharing or equal grouping. Infact, it is actually repeated subtraction. Instead of subtracting 2 repeatedly 4 times, we can write it in a short way as $8 \div 2 = 4$.
 $8 \div 2 = 4$ is a division fact.

It is read as ' 8 divided by 2 is equal to 4'. This is a division statement.

8	÷	2	=	4
The number we divide is the <u>dividend</u>		the number by which we divide is the <u>divisor</u>		the number we get is the <u>quotient</u>
