• We use 'am' when referring to our self.

For example: I am sad. I am a man. I am unhappy.

• We use '<u>are'</u>when referring to <u>someone or something</u>(in the plural). We use 'are' when referring to <u>more than one</u>.

We use 'are' with 'you. Example: You are not going home.

For example: The men are snoring loudly. Our kids are leaving.
