- We use 'is' when referring to someone or something (in the singular). We use 'is' when referring to one.

We use 'is' with 'it.' Example: It is a long break from work.

For example: Tom is hungry. He is cute.

- We use 'am' when referring to our self.

For example: I am sad. I am a man. I am unhappy.

- We use 'are' when referring to someone or something (in the plural). We use 'are' when referring to more than one.

We use 'are' with 'you.' Example: You are not going home.

For example: The men are snoring loudly. Our kids are leaving.
