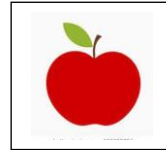

SENTENCES

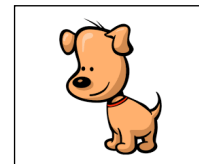
A Sentence is a group of words which forms a proper meaning giving a complete thought.

- *A sentence must have a subject and a verb.*
- *A sentence starts with a capital letter.*
- *After the sentence ends, suitable punctuation must be put according to the kind of sentence.*

- *A sentence must have a subject and a verb.*
- *For example: The man is eating an egg.
Here, the man is the subject and eating is the verb.*



- *A sentence starts with a capital letter.*
- *For example: The dog ran fast.
Here, the sentence begins with a capital letter The*



- *After the sentence ends, suitable punctuation must be put according to the kind of sentence.*
- *For example: I just finished reading the book.*
- *Did you read the book?*
- *Read this amazing book!*



- **Use commas in a series**
Apples, oranges and bananas are on sale.

Types of Sentences

Declarative- a statement

For example: I have a basketball match tonight.



Interrogative- a question

For example: Will you come for the match?



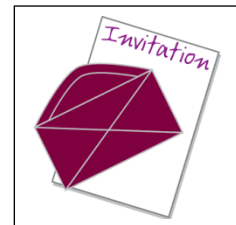
Exclamatory – An exclamation

For example: We won the game!



Imperative- a command or request

For example: Please come and watch me play.
