SENTENCES

A Sentence is a group of words which forms a proper meaning giving a complete thought.

- A sentence must have a subject and a verb.
- A sentence starts with a capital letter.
- After the sentence ends, suitable punctuation must be put according to the kind of sentence.
- A sentence must have a subject and a verb.
- For example: The man is eating an egg.
 Here, the man is the subject and eating is the verb.



- A sentence starts with a capital letter.
- For example: <u>The</u> dog ran fast.
 Here, the sentence begins with a capital letter <u>The</u>



- After the sentence ends, suitable punctuation must be put according to the kind of sentence.
- For example: I just finished reading the book
- Did you read the book?
- Read this amazing book!



Use commas in a series

Types of Sentences

Declarative- a statement

For example: I have a basketball match tonight.



Interrogative- a question

For example: Will you come for the match?



Exclamatory – An exclamation For example: We won the game!



Imperative- a command or request

For example: Please come and watch me play.
