- 1.A motion for reduction of any demand of grant is called **cut motion**.
- 2. The purpose of Cut Motion is to point out **specific grievance** of a member against a demand.
- 3. Reduction of expenditure is known as economy cut.
- 4. To express a grievance of a member against a Demand is called Motion of Token Cut.
- 5. <u>Calling Attention Motion</u> is for short discussion on any matter of urgent public importance.
- 6.The **Speaker** allows the Calling Attention Motion if he deems necessary.
- 7. The Council of Ministers remain **collectively** responsible to lower house of the parliament.
- 8. No Confidence Resolution can be moved against the **Cabinet**.
- 9. No Confidence is moved by the <u>leader</u> of the opposition.
- 10. The support of minimum of <u>50</u> members are required to carry out the No Confidence.
- 11. The motion for No Confidence will be taken up for discussion within <u>10 days</u> from the day on which it is granted.
- 12. A **Censure Motion** expresses strong disapproval of the policy of individual member.
- 13. Censure Motion can be moved only by stating the reasons.
- 14. Adoption of Censure Motion against Council of Ministers means resignation of the **Government.**
- 15. Adoption of Censure Motion against individual minister has no effect.
