1. Most of the states including West Bengal donot have <u>legislative council.</u>

2. After a bill is passed by the assembly it awaits **governor's** approval.

3. If the legislature is **prorogued** then a bill shall not lapse.

4. When Legislative assembly is **<u>dissolved</u>** the bill proposed in the legislative council and not passed in the Assembly will be rejected.

5. If Council does not pass the bill within <u>**3 months**</u> of the date of the receipt the State Legislative Assembly may pass the bill without amendments.

6. If a bill is sent to the Council second time and not passed within <u>1 month</u> of its receipt then the bill stands passes in both the houses.

7. A money bill is introduced in the **Legislative assembly.** 

8. The Council after receiving the money bill must sent it back within <u>14 days</u> with or without recommendations.

9. There should be a gap of <u>6 months</u> between two sessions in the parliament.

10. The President addresses the joint sittings of both the houses after each **general** elections.

11. **Speaker Protem** is a temporary speaker.

12. <u>Motion of Thanks</u> provides opportunity for elaborate discussion of matters referred to in the address.

13. The first hour of sitting of every day of both Houses of Parliament Is known as **Question Hour.** 

14. Zero Hour starts at 12 O' clock.

15. In Adjournment motion the matter raised should be of **public interest.**
