| 1. The highest value is $90^{\circ}$. | 1. The highest value is $180^{\circ}$. |
| 2. They are 179 in number. | 2. They are 360 in number. |
| 3. They are all full circles. | 3. They are all half circles. |
| 4. Their length diminishes pole ward. | 4. Their length remains the same. |
| 5. They are equidistant from each other. | 5. They are farthest near the Equator but merge at the poles. |
| 6. Apart from the Equator they are all marked as N or S . | 6. Apart from the Prime Meridian they are all marked as E or W. |
