- 1. All disputes regarding election of President shall be decided by the **<u>Supreme Court.</u>**
- 2. The President takes the oath before <u>Chief Justice</u> of Supreme Court.
- 3. The person contesting for Presidentship should have completed **<u>35 years</u>** of age.
- 4. A president is removed through impeachment.
- 5. The president is not liable to **prosecution.**

6. To move a notice of impeachment in the concerned house minimum <u>**14 days**</u> are required to wait.

7. According to **President's Pension Act**, he receives income tax free emoluments.

- 8. The president appoints the Election Commission.
- 9. The president is entitled to **both i & ii (sign treaties & Declare War)**
- 10. According to article **<u>86(2)</u>** President can send messages to both houses if required.
- 11. A Bill passed in both House of Parliament needs President's assent to become an act.
- 12. Article 352 deals with the National Emergency.

13. 44<sup>th</sup> Amendment Act made it **obligatory** for President not to issue proclamation of emergency unless Union gives in writing.

- 14. Parliament is empowered to legislate any subject during national emergency.
- 15. Article **<u>19</u>** says Fundamental Rights are suspended during national emergency.
