13. 44<sup>th</sup> Amendment Act made it obligatory for President not to issue proclamation of emergency unless Union gives in writing.
14. Parliament is empowered to legislate any subject during national emergency.
15. Article 19 says Fundamental Rights are suspended during national emergency.
