### 2. Medieval period of Indian history.

#### 3. Harshavardhana

Harshavardhana was an Indian emperor who ruled over the northern parts of India. Harshavardhana was also known as Harsha. He was a member of the Vardhana dynasty. The capital of Harsha was Kanauj. Harsha was a great patron of art and literature. The Chinese traveller Hiueng Tsang visited India during his reign and spoke highly of the rule of Harsha. The Dana ceremony was practiced by Harsha at Prayag. He gave away all wealth he gathered over the previous years.

#### 4. Mahatma Gandhi.

The Indian nationalist leader Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi was born on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 1869 at Porbandar. He was the leader of India's non-violent independence movement against British. He stressed the importance of economic independence for India. Satyagraha movement was started by Gandhiji. He started the manufacture and use of khaddar or home spun cloth in order to replace imported textile. He is considered as the Father of the Nation and is popularly called Mahatma Gandhi.
