- **1.** Answer the following questions.
- a. What do you understand by first aid? Write any five things we should keep in a first aid box. Name any two places where we must keep a first aid box. Define safety rules. What should be done in order to avoid accidents?

Ans. First aid is the immediate help given to an injured person before the arrival of a doctor. The five things we should keep in the first aid box are cotton, band-aid, bandage, skin ointment, antiseptic solution and scissors. We must keep a first aid box at home and at school.
