Adverbs are words that add meaning to verbs, adjectives or other adjectives in a sentence. We can also call them how, when and where words. They tell how an action is done, when it is done and where it is done.
Adverbs of manner tell us how actions are done. Adverbs of time tell us when actions are done. Adverbs of place tell us where the actions are done.
We should always do our work carefully. He carefully shows the manner in which the work is done.
